Tuition Assistance Process

Riverdale desires to make tuition support available for students in need. Our tuition support policy and process is as follows:

1. The parent will express need for financial support either before or during the initial meeting.
2. The principal will ask how much support is needed and to provide proof of income.
3. The principal will then confer with the board to determine if there is a bursary available to provide to the student.
4. The amount of the bursary will be in reflection of the following:
 - a. Amount of parent(s) income
 - b. Other children at home
 - c. Any trauma the child has experienced
5. Once the board determines the amount of assistance the student will receive, the parent(s) will be notified.

Students will be selected to receive a bursary on a case-by-case basis. The board has the final decision for what bursaries are given out.

Bursaries will be given out twice per year per student. Students will either receive a cash bursary to pay tuition or a reduced tuition rate. The dates the cash bursaries will be given are September 1 and February 1 of every year.
